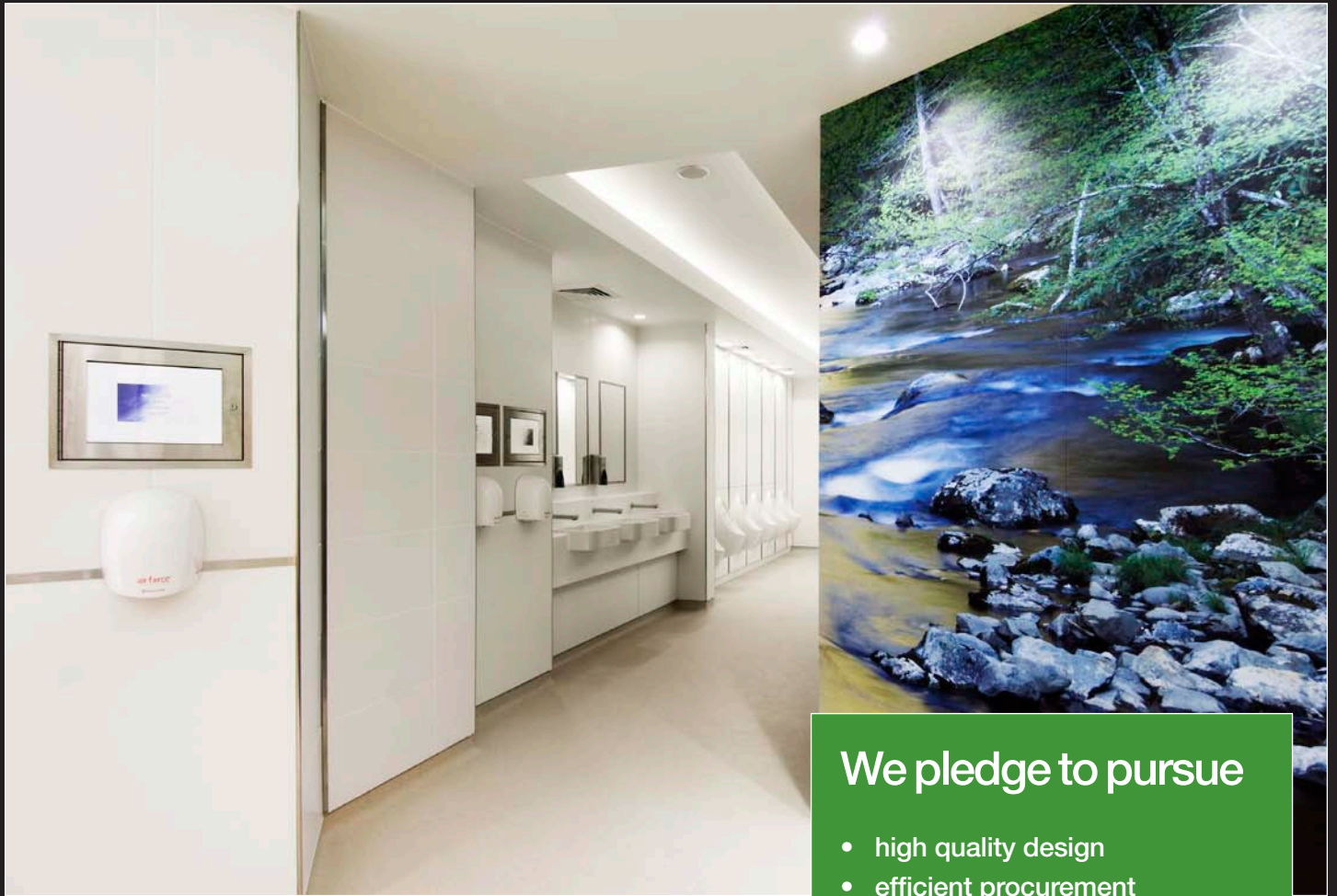

It is estimated that 13% of construction waste is new unused materials.

**Reducing waste of this type could save you time and money by decreasing removal and landfill taxes, as well as well as being beneficial to the environment.**
